National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass

The "America the Beautiful" National Park Pass provides entrance or access to more than 2,000 Federal recreation sites. Annual Pass	Cost	\$80.00	- Valid for one full year from month of purchase
Senior Pass	Cost	\$10.00	-Lifetime pass for US citizens 62 years and older
Access Pass	Cost	FREE	-Lifetime pass for permanently disabled US citizens
Volunteer Pass	Cost	FREE	-Annual pass to volunteers who contribute 250+ hours
Military Pass	Cost	FREE	-Annual pass to US Military - Active and Reserves

Arizona State Park Annual Pass

Arizona State Parks Pass provides access to 30 State Parks and Natural areas throughout Arizona. The parks located in the Verde Valley include Dead Horse Ranch in Cottonwood; Fort Verde in Camp Verde; Douglas Mansion in Jerome; Red Rock State Park and Slide Rock State Park both in Sedona.



The Standard Annual Arizona State Park Pass allows day-use to all of Arizona State Parks, except at Lake Havasu, Cattail Cove, Buckskin Mountain and River Island on weekends (Friday-Sunday) and state holidays from April 1st to October 31st.

Standard Pass Cost \$75.00 -Pass expires 12 months from date of purchase

The Premium Annual Arizona State Park Pass allows day-use to ALL Arizona State Parks.

Premium Pass Cost \$200.00-Pass expires 12 months from date of purchase

The Veterans Discount Program provides 50% day -use discount to all active duty, guard and reserve military Veterans, along with AZ resident retired military Veterans and Service Disabled Veterans. You will need to request a discount pass from a park Visitor Center. The discount pass is free and valid for 2 years. Red Rock Pass

A Red Rock Pass is required when recreating on National Forest land in Red Rock Country. The pass must be displayed in the windshield of the vehicle or will be subject to receiving a citation. A pass is not required for stops 15 minutes or less.



Daily Pass	Cost	\$5.00	-good for one calendar day
Weekly Pass	Cost	\$15.00	-good for seven consecutive days
Annual Pass	Cost	\$20.00	-good for 12 consecutive months
Grand Annual Pass	Cost	\$40.00	-good for 12 consecutive months including day-use sites
